In the late 1950s, two Giulietta Spider Veloce's came to Portland. They were featured on a local

TV show to promote a sports car race

which they dominated, winning converts in the growing sports car scene. As interest and knowledge of Alfas grew, Alfa fans — known as “Alfisti” — began to gather at Rambo Motors, the new Alfa dealer in Portland, which trained mechanics and supported a racing team. In the early 1960s, Bob Rinde, Rambo’s sales manager, joined the national Alfa Romeo Owners Club and others followed. By October 1968 there was enough local interest for Bob McGill to apply to start a chapter, making AROO the sixth AROC-US chapter.

Alfa Romeo Tonale SUV



Alfa Romeo Tonale Leaked Photos?

The new Alfa Romeo Tonale small SUV is getting closer to reality. We saw it first in concept form earlier this year, and now the first images of the production car have leaked out. Alfa Romeo refuses to say whether these images are legit, but given its close resemblance to the concept car, we're thinking this must be it.

While the vehicle in the leaked photos is certainly more ordinary-looking than the bright-red, flashy concept, the gray Tonale in these photos does display classic Alfa design cues, such as the

brand's distinctive grille shape and sharply creased sheetmetal along the body sides.

The Tonale will be smaller than the Stelvio and will compete with such vehicles as the BMW X1/X2, Audi Q3, and Volvo XC40. In contrast to the Stelvio and Giulia, which have a rear-wheel-drive platform, the Tonale will be based on a front-wheel-drive architecture, although we're not exactly sure which one.

Alfa Romeo has also said that the Tonale will offer a hybrid powertrain of some sort, though we don't know if that means a plug-in or just a conventional hybrid. In addition to the hybrid, we expect it will come with a turbocharged 2.0-liter four-cylinder engine. We're sure it will offer all-wheel drive, possibly as an option, and it will likely be priced starting in the \$30,000 range.

Alfa Romeo is being tightlipped about when the Tonale will arrive, but we predict that we'll see it either late this year or early next year. That means that—if it comes to the U.S., which we suspect it will—it will likely go on sale here as a 2021 model.

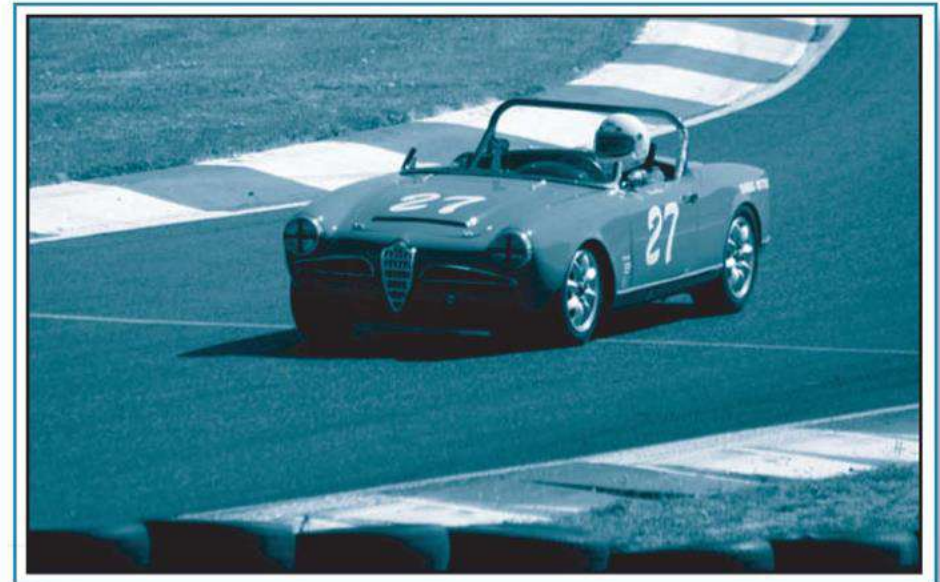

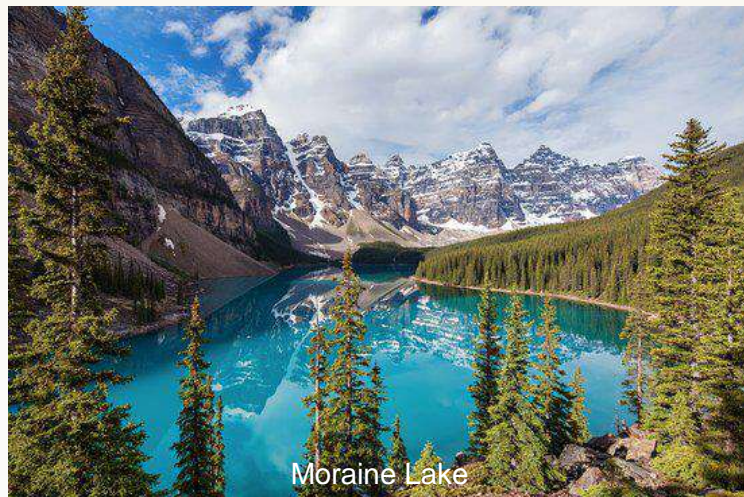

2020-CANADIAN ROCKIES -TAKE 2! Banff, Lake Louise, Moraine Lake and Hot Springs June 20-28, 2020

This eight night-nine day tour will feature the beauty of the Canadian Rockies, soothing mineral waters of five different hot springs, *luxury* lakeside lodging on Lake Louise and Moraine Lake, great food and stellar scenery (and some very nice roads!). Day 1: The trip will depart June 20th from Portland. The trip will feature back roads through the Palouse to Spokane and [the Historic Davenport Hotel](#). This is a very classy elegant hotel that we have visited on past tours and all have really enjoyed.

Days 4-5 we stay in the famous [Fairmount Chateau Lake Louise](#). Located in the high in the Canadian Rockies only a short distance from Banff, you will have the opportunity to enjoy high tea, explore several walking trails, paddle a canoe while you gaze at mountains and glaciers, and take the Lake Louise Tram to the top of the mountains with a good chance of seeing a grizzly bear! We will also take shuttles over to Lake Moraine and have the opportunity to enjoy perhaps even more spectacular sights. Check out the pics! Wow!

Day 6 has us heading to Jasper where we stay in the Fairmont Jasper Lodge. We will take in the many sights along the Ice Highway including mountain lakes, waterfalls, the Columbia Ice Fields, and a lot more.

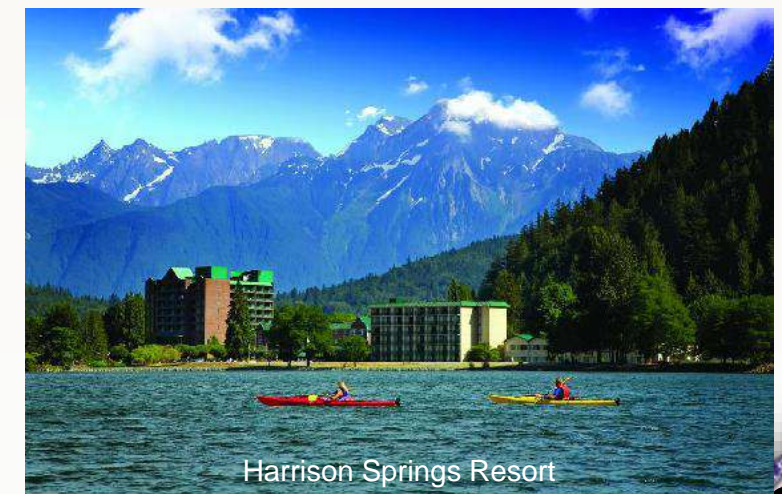
Day 9: Home bound we are.

This will be one of those "Once in a life time" trips for most of us. The trip will not be cheap. The rooms at Lake Louise and Moraine Lake run \$950 to \$1,000 Canadian or \$713-\$750 US (but I got a group discount so a bit less) but like I said, a once in a lifetime opportunity.

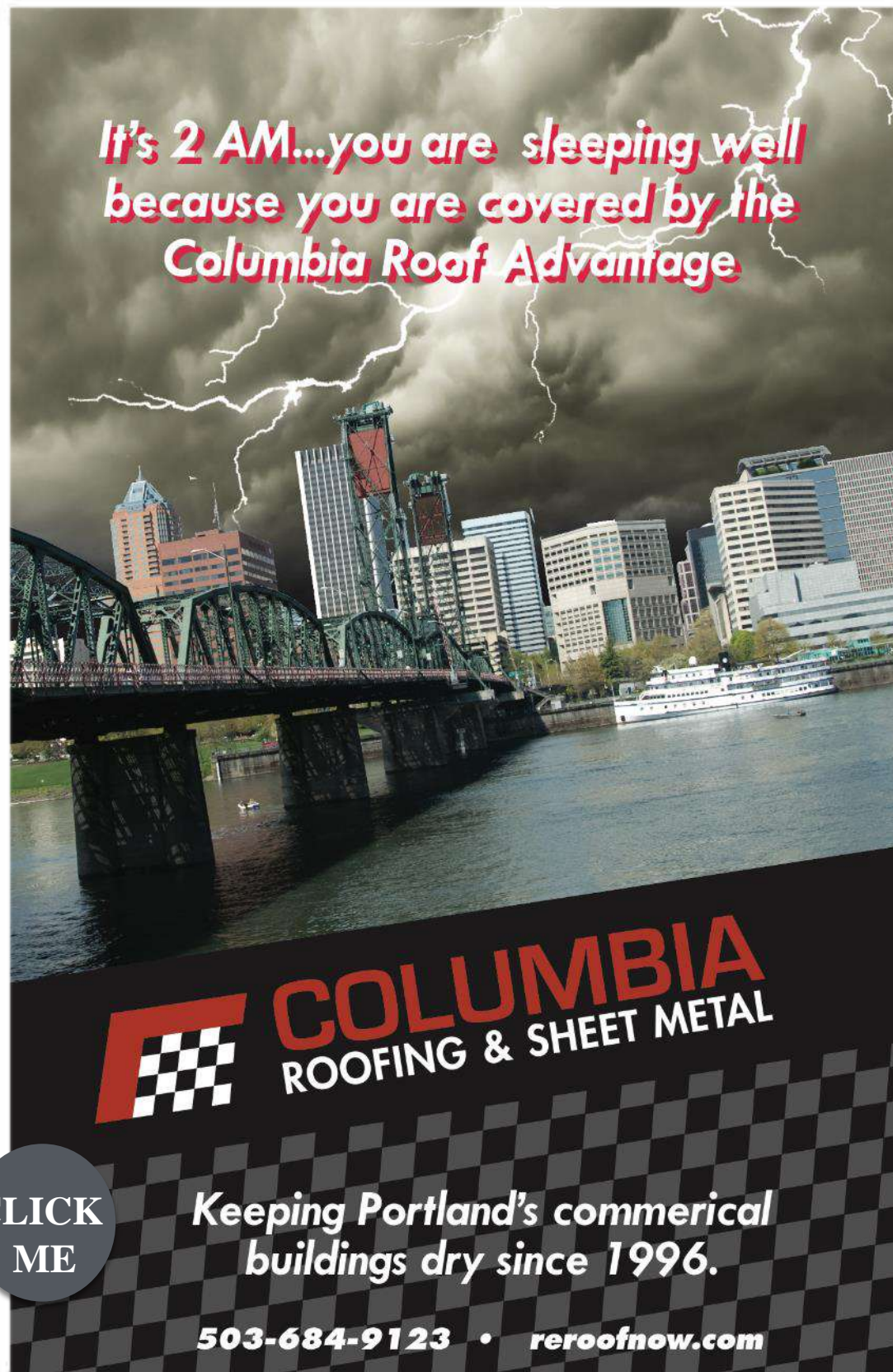
The only time Paula and I attempted to make it to Lake Louise we were on a year delayed honeymoon camping in a park down the road. We decided to hike the trail from the main highway to The Chateau. 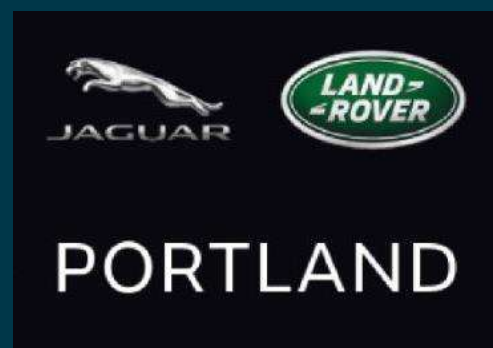

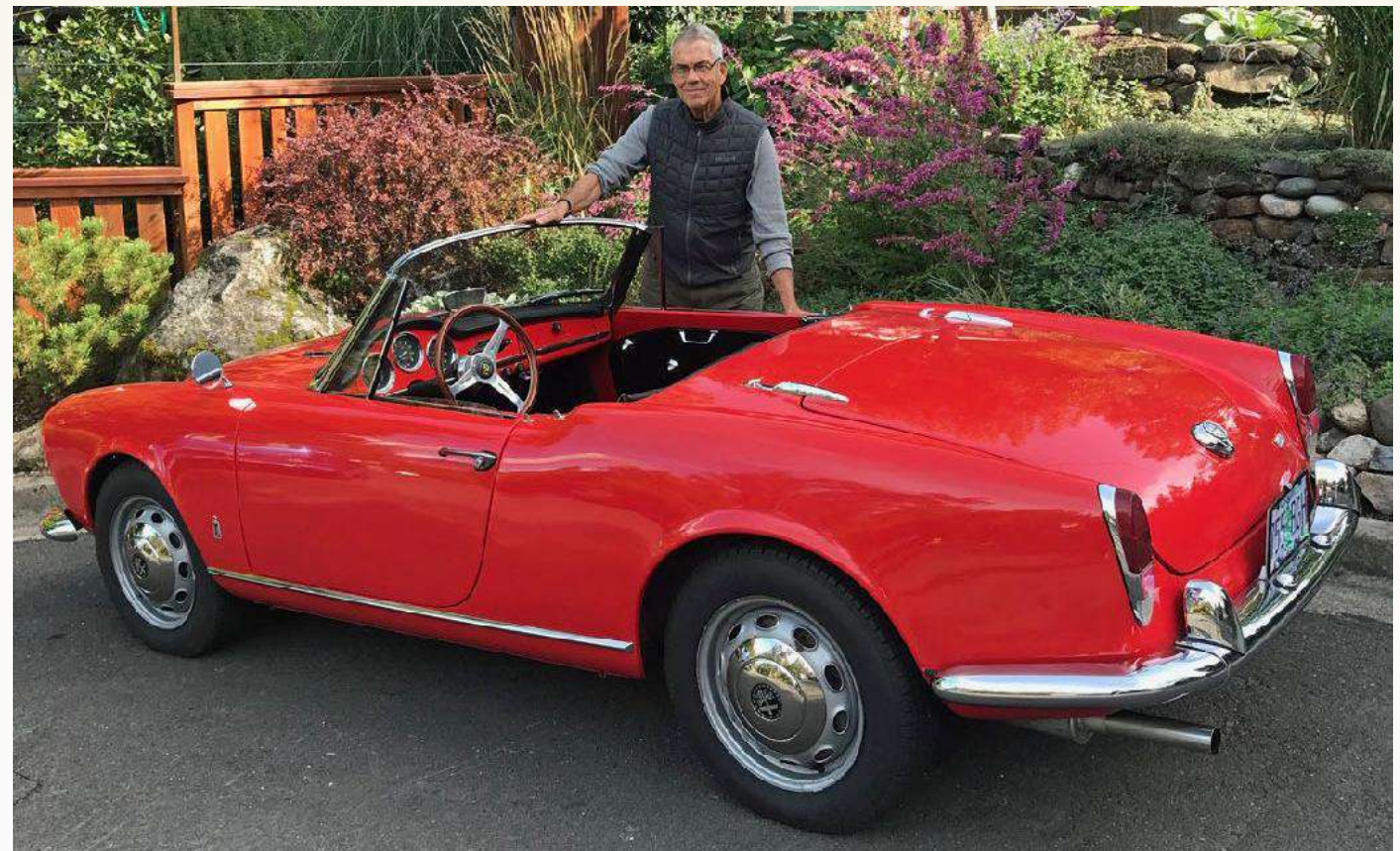
